This scholarship was established in memory of Zachary Capra who graduated from Mountain Range High School, Class of 2011. Zachary was a Navy Veteran and was studying to become a commercial airline pilot at Embry Riddle Aeronautical University. Zachary was killed April 4, 2018, when the small engine plane he was flying crashed just after takeoff in Daytona Beach, FL while he was conducting his final check ride to obtain his commercial pilot's license. Zachary was awarded a posthumous degree of Bachelor of Science in Aeronautics.

Award: \$2,500

Purpose: Assistance with tuition, fees, supplies and other expenses at a 2-year community college, career technical or other trade school.

To Be Eligible You Must:

- Be a high school senior at MRHS
- Have a minimum 2.0 GPA
- Be planning to enroll as a student at a 2-year community college, trade program or technical school.

Selection Process: The selection committee will consider the applicant's:

- Personal Essay
- High school volunteer and community service record, honors and awards that demonstrate the applicant's leadership skills
- High school transcript(s) for Grade 9 through the first semester of Grade 12

Letters of Recommendation: Two (2) letters of recommendation are required.

- One (1) from a teacher, administrator or counselor and
- One (1) from a community member who is not a family member, preferably someone who has "supervised" the applicant in a leadership role.

Application Process: Please complete and provide (1) the application; (2) personal essay; (3) transcript(s); and (4) two letters of recommendation and deliver <u>one</u> copy of each to the counseling office at your high school.

Note: If any portion of the application is incomplete or not included the application will not be considered. Additional materials of any kind will not be considered.

Deadline: Must be delivered to the Counseling Office by April 15th.
