When completing the application for admission, you will need to create an account with a **user ID** and **password**. Please keep this information for your records. You will need to login with this password should you need to update your application.

A couple of other hints for completing the application for admission:

- In the **Academic Plans** section, make sure to **select**:
  - **Start Date or Entry Term** – select **“Fall 2021”**
  - **Goal** - “Take college courses while I’m still in high school”
  - **Area of Interest** - “All Academic Programs”
  - **Degree or Certificate** - Choose “Associate of Arts” or “Associate of Science”
  - **Concentration Choice** - Can leave blank or fill in
  - **Campus Attending** - “FRCC Westminster campus”
- In the **High School** section:
  - Enter your **High School name** and **State** only. Then proceed to search! **Don’t** search by city
  - Make sure you click “select” when result finds **your high school (Legacy, Mountain Range etc)**
  - Select **“yes”** for “have you or will you earn a high school diploma...”
  - Select “No, I am a current high school student who will not graduate prior to the semester for which I am applying (aka concurrent enrollment student)”
- In the **Residency Information** section:
  - Select citizenship status and enter social security number if applicable
  - Have you attended a Colorado High School for three years and been admitted or will be admitted to a Colorado higher education institution within 12 months of your graduation/GED completion?
    - If you attended high school in Colorado in 10<sup>th</sup> grade (or earlier), you can click **yes**. If you moved from another state to Colorado after 10<sup>th</sup> grade, you click **no**.
- In the **Signature** section, make sure to say **“yes” to apply for the College Opportunity Fund** which is a free stipend that pays for a portion of your in-state tuition cost
- Make sure to click on **“Submit Application”** when you are all finished!

As an open enrollment institution, you are accepted to FRCC once you complete your application and the application is FREE to submit! Your **student ID number (S number)** will be issued once you submit the application online. Your S number will be needed to register for classes, among other things. You can retrieve your S number by clicking on the “My Account” link at the top of the application or by signing back into the account you created to fill out the application. Your S# will be emailed to the email address you provide.
