



Greeting from Red Rocks Community College (RRCC) and Washington Square.

Good news! Your high School student is enrolled in a Concurrent Enrollment course. Concurrent Enrollment is a state program that allows high school students in grades 9-12 to take classes for dual credit (high school and college). RRCC tuition (typically \$153 per credit hour) is paid by Adams 12 through state funding, a value of over \$450 per 3 credit class! There is no cost to the student for any Concurrent Enrollment courses.

These credits start an RRCC transcript which can be used towards a degree, certificate or may transfer to another college or university **with grades of C or higher**.

To earn college credit, students must complete the following:

STEP 1: Apply- complete the free online RRCC application at: www.rrcc.edu/admissions. This establishes a RRCC Account and student ID number.

Click "YES" when asked if you would like to establish a College Opportunity Fund (COF) account. The College Opportunity Fund pays part of the student's Concurrent Enrollment tuition, along with the district, resulting in **no** cost for you or your student.

STEP 2: Complete and submit your Concurrent Enrollment Agreement - To receive college credit, you must complete, sign and submit a completed and signed Concurrent Enrollment Agreement at:

The form is due no later than: September 6, 2021

Registration Deadline Fall Semester: September 6, 2021

Participation/enrollment requirements: Red Rocks Community College requires Concurrent Enrollment classes to have at least 50% participation in Career Tech Education courses and 80% participation in Guaranteed Transfer academic courses. Lack of participation may result in class cancelations.
